Touristic Places in and Around Rize



Rize Castle (City Center)

Located in the city center, Rize Castle offers panoramic views of both the city and the Black Sea. It's a great place for a relaxing walk and enjoying tea with a scenic backdrop.



Zilkale (Çamlıhemşin)

Located on a cliff overlooking the Firtina River in the foothills of the Kaçkar Mountains, Zilkale is a medieval castle offering stunning views and historical atmosphere. It is about 1.5 hours from Rize city center.









Ayder Plateau (Çamlıhemşin)

One of Turkey's most famous highlands, Ayder is known for its lush nature, thermal springs, and trout restaurants. With its cool climate and natural beauty, it's a favorite summer destination.



Firtina River

Firtina River is one of the most iconic rivers of the Black Sea region, popular for rafting and zipline activities. It's the perfect spot for nature lovers and adventure seekers.

Botanical Garden (City Center)

The Rize Botanical Garden features tropical and local plant species, ideal for nature enthusiasts. Situated on a hill, it offers walking paths and stunning views of the city and sea.

Tea Bazaar & Giant Tea Glass (City Center)

Symbolizing Rize's world-renowned tea production, this area features a giant tea glass sculpture—perfect for photo opportunities. Visitors can also taste and purchase local teas from nearby shops.

Şenyuva (Çinçiva) Bridge

An Ottoman-era stone bridge located in the district of Çamlıhemşin, Şenyuva Bridge is a charming, historic site nestled in nature—ideal for photography and peaceful walks.

Palovit Waterfall

Located within Kaçkar Mountains National Park, Palovit Waterfall is one of the region's most powerful waterfalls. Surrounded by lush forests, it's a must-see natural wonder.

Elevit, Pokut, and Gito Plateaus

Less crowded than Ayder but equally stunning, these highland plateaus offer a more authentic and tranquil Black Sea experience. With fog-covered mountains, traditional wooden houses, and untouched nature, they are perfect for a serene escape.
